

Stop the Bunyip North Quarry !

What is being proposed?

A massive granite quarry extracting up to 2 million tonnes of granite yearly for 100 years located less than 400 metres from the border of beautiful Mt. Cannibal which is listed in the Victorian Heritage database as a site of regional significance.

Potential impacts of plans by Hanson Construction Materials to turn this clean and green area into a granite quarry that would make a huge impact on local communities and wildlife corridors.

The total area of land purchased by Hanson for this proposal is approximately the size of Brew Road, Mt. Shamrock and Tynong North quarries combined.
